Nomination periods

- Autumn 2024: 15–31 March
- Spring 2024: 15–30 September

Partner universities will receive an email with instructions on how to nominate students via Lund University's online nomination system SoleMove. After the nomination period, a student login ID and password will be generated so that each nominated student can apply during the application period.
